## STATE IN VARSITY CROSS COUNTRY

### Girls Earn 2A Championship

### Bridget Kennedy Takes 1st Place!

The varsity cross country teams competed in the TCAL state cross country meet in College Station on Saturday, October 18. Both teams performed wonderfully on what was by far the most challenging course of the season.

The varsity girls are the class 2A champions and the varsity boys are the class 2A state runners up! Six of our athletes placed in the 2A top five - Bridget Kennedy placed first, AmyGrace Weems second, Ana Henriquez fourth, and Abbie Brady fifth. In the boys division, Cole Hivnor placed fourth and Luke Griego placed fifth

The boys team finished 5th in the state, and the girls finished 3rd in the state. AmyGrace Weems and Bridget Kennedy both made the girls all-state team. Amy Grace placed seventh with a two-mile time of 15:16. Bridget Kennedy not only placed first in the 2A division, but also won the overall state champion title with a time of 12:56. This is the second year in a row that Bridget has won state in the 2A division.
