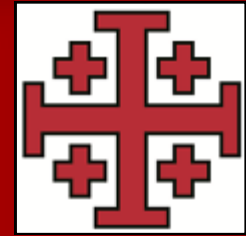

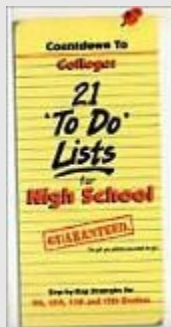

Each item may be checked out for 2 weeks and renewed as needed.

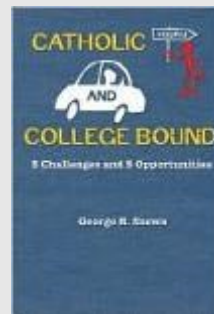
